Visit Baxter Memorial Library to have fun with science. Follow the 5 step scientific method to perform experiments to learn how our world works. (geared toward ages 6 and up)



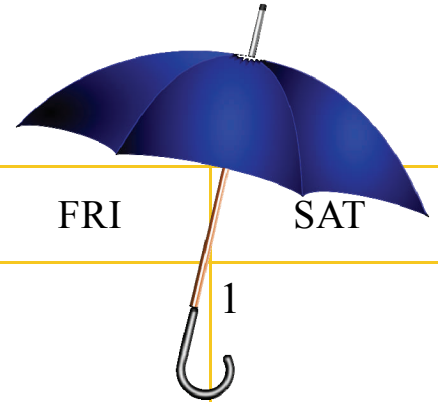
Friday, April 21st 10-11am – Bird Tweets
