WCSH weatherman Kevin Mannix and his wife Linda Rota, coauthors of *Weathering Shame*, share their stories of struggling with stigma and shame from childhood traumas. As adults, they had both come to recognize that those experiences had influenced their own behaviors and choices. In recognizing and coming to terms with past traumas, they had gained a greater understanding of their lives and developed a deeper sense of self.

Their goal is two-fold: to encourage others to embark on their own journey of self-discovery and to encourage society to become more compassionate and less stigmatizing.

welcome.

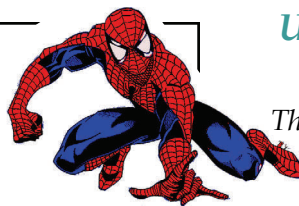


