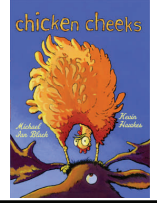
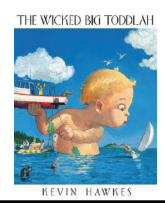
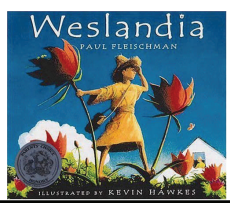
Our Spring book sale will start on

 Paul Doiron

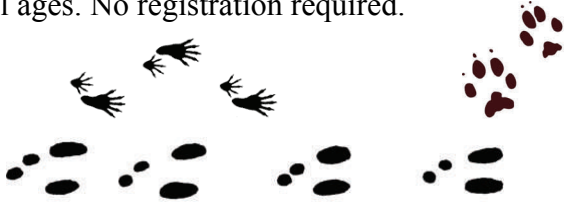

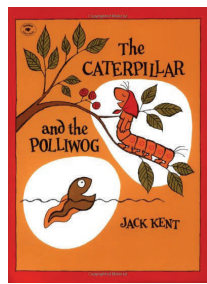
A signing will follow Mr. Doiron's presentation. The Bookworm will have copies of his books on hand to purchase. This program is geared toward adults.
