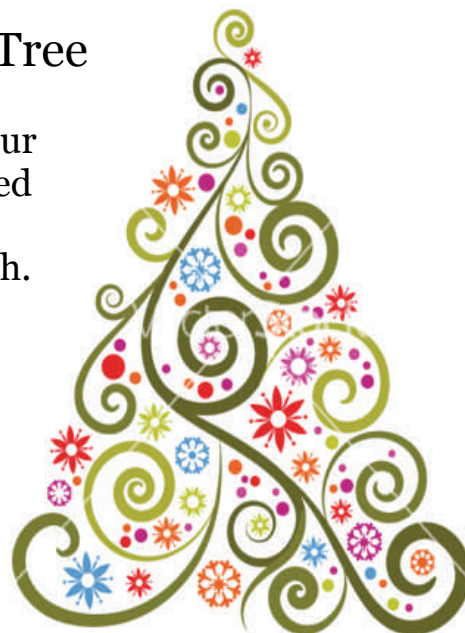

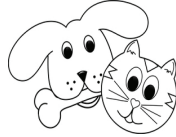
## Baxter Memorial Library Annual Giving Tree
