### Italian Turkey Stuffing submitted by Pat Capozza

| 8 large eggs               | 1/4 cup parsley                |
| 10 cups fresh bread crumbs | 2 cups giblets, finely chopped |
| 1 large onion, chopped     | 1 tbsp. garlic powder          |
| 2 stalks celery, diced     | Pepper                         |
| 1 cup Romano cheese        | 1 (20lb.) Turkey               |
| 1 tsp. salt                |                                |

Sauté onion, celery and giblets until onion is golden brown. In a large bowl, mix together the bread crumbs, cheese, salt, pepper, parsley and garlic powder. Add all of the sautéed mixture to the dry mixture. Add the eggs one at a time, until mixture is moist and stays together. Spoon into both cavities (breast and tail) of the bird. Sew cavities. Cook turkey covered for 30 minutes per pound at 325°. Baste every hour. Uncover during the last 30 minutes to brown. Remove stuffing (like a loaf of bread) and slice to serve.
