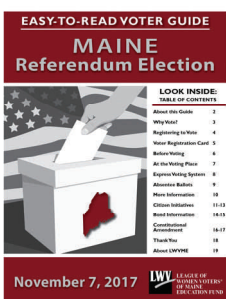



**Family Game Night**
