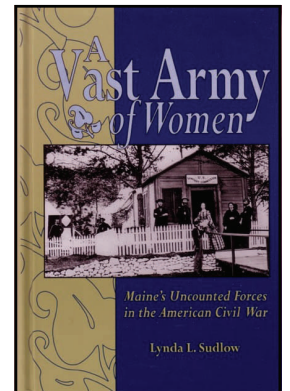
Author Event: Lyn Sudlow
