Babb's Bridge

From great beams Babb's Covered Bridge suspended provides each side an opposite to tread set into banks cut when glaciers ended and water filled where gravity had led. Positioned piece on piece its granite blocks became (once leveled for the eye to see) twin bases where above the jagged rocks two townships met in 1843. To build secure o'er these running waters construction calculation drawings showed wagons freely crossing as if otters could carry weight were loaded up tenfold. By good design it fends off rain and sleet that fall into Presumscot's winding course while offering to all it ever greets protection should the weather turn for worse. In villages and towns our Pine Tree State

yet gathers Sunday mornings pew by pew

to hear inspired words- that- "good awaits"
those persons living by the Golden Rule.
Could efforts to maintain be better made
than tending to a passageway of spruce
built back when neighbor unto neighbor gave
this open-ended gift... now still in use?
